3ND FORUM FREE NATIONS OF POSTRUSSIA



The imperial character, form, and essence of the modern Russian Federation are not just one of the options, not just a threat, it is a diagnosis: as long as Russia remains a single state ruled from the imperial center, it will enslave its citizens and threaten ALL its own by all means (including the military). neighbors and peace throughout the world.

New collective security architecture and long-term peace both in Europe and globally are impossible while Russia exists as a single state.

The fact of its existence in this form is constant and systematic: hybrid attacks, proxy attacks, state terrorism, controlled outcasts, corrupt officials, massive propaganda, affiliated criminals, and real large-scale wars - including a high probability of starting a nuclear one.

For the citizens themselves (more precisely, the subjects, because the inhabitants of Russia do not have real rights and freedoms) of the Russian Federation, the continuation of its existence in its current form means denunciations, arrests, repressions, and quite likely - very soon camps, deportations, and executions, that is, the return of classic practitioners of Stalinism during the "flourishing" in 1937-1938.









But the logic of history is inexorable - empires always fall apart (and the last empire in Europe, of course, is no exception).

Russia will soon face a complete collapse and chaos (with a high degree of probability - and civil war), and the only way to avoid this is to act preventively.

The process of disintegration, or rather the Decolonization of the Russian Federation, should be controlled, only in this way it is possible to minimize the risks of violence and bloodshed, ensure the complete denuclearization of all independent successor states of the Russian Federation, their denazification-decommunization (with a tribunal for ideologists and leaders of war crimes, repressions, terrorist attacks) and lustration - significantly increase the chances that a significant part of the new states will become not only successful but also liberal, open and democratic.

Today's imperial Russian Federation is not a great country, it's just very, very big, huge (and this is the root of its problems), and for example, small Lithuania, Estonia, and Denmark are not only much more comfortable for the life of their citizens (where the economy is competitive, the legal field is not a fiction, rights, and freedoms are guaranteed), but they are also objectively, qualitatively, constructively and positively active on the world geopolitical arena.

Small, but comfortable, open to the world and free countries - this is what the citizens of the independent states of Post-Russia need to come to.

It is for this purpose that on September 23-25, 2002, the 3rd Forum of Free Nations of PostRussia will be held in Gdansk (Republic of Poland).

The First (05/08/22 in Warsaw) and Second (07/22-24/22 in Prague) Forums of the FNR, as well as the adoption of the Declaration on the Decolonization of the Russian Federation within the framework of the 2nd Forum in Prague, not only drew attention to the idea but also significantly intensified the process of De-imperialization of the Russian Federation.

The focus of attention of the 3rd FNP Forum (the organizers have already announced the 4th and 5th FNP Forums that will be held before the end of 2022) in Gdansk will be the "old-new" states of Post-Russia in the regions of the Baltic and Scandinavia, primarily Ingria, Karelia and the Baltic Republic / Koenigsberg (as well as potential neighbors for the Baltic and Scandinavian countries - Smalandia / Smolensk Territory, Pskov, Novgorod, Pomorie / Biarmia, Lapland / Murmansk Republic, Komi), their liberation from the Kremlin empire and return to their native European penates.

Like the previous two Forums, the event in Gdansk will be held in a hybrid format, where there will be both online and offline performances (as well as a live online broadcast of the Forum with open access for everyone).

Among the speakers of the 3rd FNP Forum there will be representatives of different strata, groups, and "factions" from the respective regions (for now) of the Russian Federation, representatives of the EU and NATO states (diplomats, MEPs, ministers, politicians), European, British and American intellectuals, public opinion leaders, activists, media representatives.

The reconstruction of the post-Russian states is an integral part of the controlled strategy of its Decolonization.

All constructive forces (both at the state level and the corporate, non-governmental, and private levels) in the world should contribute to the processes of economic, social, cultural, and trade development of the Post-Russian states, their integration into the new architecture of both regional and global security systems, customized Marshall plans for each specific state of the post-Russian space, as an element of a policy, the transformation of yesterday's crazy aggressor and the bloody unprincipled Enfant terrible into a galaxy of civilized modern liberal states (cases of Japan and Germany after World War II):

- scenarios of peaceful, non-violent, and controlled secession, independence, and success of the new states of the Baltic and Scandinavian regions of the post-Russian space,
- denuclearization and demilitarization (HOW exactly to ensure peace and nuclear security for the European Community in the process of reconstruction of the post-Russian space)
- minimizing the risks of migration crises, the worsening of the crime situation, and the strengthening of terrorist threats in the process of gaining independence by certain regions
- prospects for economic, political, cultural, trade, and military interaction between the European Union and NATO with the newly independent states of the Baltic region of the post-Russian space
- building a new collective security architecture in the Baltic and Scandinavian region as a component of the global Euro-Atlantic system
- Intermarium and prospects for expanding the Baltic-Black Sea-Adriatic cooperation, including with the new states of the post-Russian space all these issues are also in the addendum of the 3rd Forum of Free Nations of Post-Russia

There are no rational reasons for holding on to the Empire by citizens (more precisely, subjects) of the Russian Federation, these are only complexes and myths of the Kremlin propaganda that plays on nostalgia (rather, even the Stockholm Syndrome) and the desire to compensate people for real stolen personal benefits with imaginary collective "state achievements".

It's time for the people of the Russian Federation to understand and accept that the assets of the state are very banal and tangible things: high-quality medicine, efficient work of public services, creation of incentives for innovation and entrepreneurship, high-quality social protection, the ability to protect their rights and property - and not unleashed wars, seizures of the territories of neighboring states and terror, both internal and external.

A galaxy of small independent states in the European part (especially in the Baltic and Scandinavian regions) of Post-Russia is the best solution to many problems.

The time has come. It is necessary to act.
